

“The Source of Paul’s Gospel”

Lesson: Galatians 1:10-24

GOLDEN TEXT:

“But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.” — Galatians 1:11-12

TODAY’S AIM:

“To show that the source of Paul’s gospel is Jesus Himself.

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

There are many people coming to our doors these days. Many such people are salesmen. It is hard to know whom to trust. We do not know what they are selling, and it is best to always ask for valid identification before dealing with them. In our lesson this week Paul states that the gospel he had come to know is the truth because it came to him directly from our Lord Jesus Christ. This was done through direct revelation to him. Paul knew that this gospel could never be wrong.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. Our aim should be to serve Christ, not please people (Galatians 1:10).
2. The gospel of Jesus has the power to change lives like nothing else can (Galatians 1:11-12).
3. The Lord can use anyone who humbles himself and joins the family of God (Galatians 1:13-14).
4. When God moves upon our hearts, we should quickly respond to His call (Galatians 1:15-17).
5. We should spend time with seasoned believers (Galatians 1:18-20).
6. We should celebrate when people who were strongly opposed to Jesus become His followers (Galatians 1:23-24).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

Think about how God reveals Himself to us deep within our souls to bring about transformation in our lives. Paul knew everything there was to know about formal religion, but it left him empty inside. The gospel is about what Jesus does in our hearts and lives as we respond to what He has already done for us on the cross.

When God speaks to us, we must be open to listening to Him. He speaks to us through His Spirit. The Spirit shows us who Jesus is.
