“Pharaoh’s Hardening Heart”

Lesson: Exodus 9:27-35

GOLDEN TEXT:

“When Pharaoh saw that the rain and the hail and the thunders were ceased, he sinned yet more, and hardened his heart, he and his servants.” (Exodus 9:34).

TODAY’S AIM:

“To see that Pharaoh seems to repent and become willing to free the Hebrews, but as soon as the plague of thunder and hail is lifted, he hardens himself again and refuses to free them.”

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

Pharaoh’s varied reactions to the Lord’s command run the gamut from skepticism to outright mockery to feigned or calculated repentance and finally to threats of physical violence. An analysis of his responses can be very helpful in anticipating and understanding the reactions of people to the claims of the gospel in our own day.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. It is foolish to make a commitment to God that you do not intend to keep (Exodus 9:27-28).
2. If we try to bargain with God, He may grant our request, but He will hold us accountable (Exodus 9:29).
3. God cannot be deceived by insincere repentance (Exodus 9:30).
4. God has all power over every force of nature (Exodus 9:31-33).
5. The devil deceives those who seek only temporary relief instead of true repentance (Exodus 9:34-35).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

True repentance is not based on fear but on enduring trust, love, and gratitude toward Jesus Christ. Pharaoh is a poignant negative example of how fear alone is insufficient to produce real, lasting repentance.
