"A Plague of Blood"

Lesson: Exodus 7:14-24

GOLDEN TEXT:

"Thus saith the Lord, In this thou shalt know that I am the Lord: behold, I will smite with the rod that is in mine hand upon the waters which are in the river, and they shall be turned to blood." — Exodus 7:17

TODAY'S AIM:

"To note that because Pharaoh would not let the Hebrews go, God struck all the waters of Egypt, turning them to blood. But Pharaoh's magicians also changed water to blood, so Pharaoh's heart was unmoved."

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

In last week's lesson, we saw that although Moses and Aaron had commanded Pharaoh in the name of the Lord to let His people go, Pharaoh had mocked the Lord not only by refusing to obey Him but also by substantially increasing the workload of his already beleaguered Hebrew slaves. In doing so, Pharaoh had haughtily provoked the Lord to wrath and judgment upon Egypt. As Hebrews 10:31 warns, "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

CHURCH

NDAY

- 1. God controls your enemies, and He prepares you to deal with them (Exodus 7:14).
- 2. When God sends you, He goes with you and directs your path (Exodus 7:15-16).
- 3. God's actions are never subject to error or defeat (Exodus 7:17-19).
- 4. When God moves on your behalf, your enemies can only stand and watch (Exodus 7:20).
- 5. Defiance of God's Word causes death and destruction (Exodus 7:21-23).
- 6. Man cannot compensate for anything that God has taken away (Exodus 7:24)

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

Just as the Lord glorified Himself by defending and delivering the Hebrews, He desires to glorify Himself today in your life. Glorify Him by loving Him and focusing on serving Him as the center of your daily living. "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure" (Philippians 2:13).
