“A Comfortable Exile”

Lesson: Exodus 2:11-25

GOLDEN TEXT:

“When Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.” — Exodus 2:15

TODAY’S AIM:

“To see that, although Moses may have felt ready to deliver God’s people, God needed to teach him humility, patience, and dependence on Him alone.”

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

In 1 Corinthians 1:27-29, Paul writes, “God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; and base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: that no flesh should glory in his presence.” Moses illustrates this principle superbly, but he had to go through a long schooling by the Lord before he could be used.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. When we respond to evil with evil, we must face the consequences (Exodus 2:11-14).
2. God’s love can find us even when we feel lost and alone (Exodus 2:15).
3. Even in poor circumstances, we can still find ways to honor God and serve others (Exodus 2:16-17).
4. The love of God is manifested in us in the way we treat each other (Exodus 2:18-20).
5. If we are Christ’s, we too are strangers here (Exodus 2:21-22).
6. God is moved with compassion when His children are in trouble (Exodus 2:23).
7. God always keeps His promises (Exodus 2:24-25).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

The qualities that impress the world are the opposite of the qualities God wants to see in His servants: humility, patience, and total dependence on Him alone.
